- Each abstract should be limited to 350 words and contain the background, hypothesis, methods, results to date (if ongoing) and discussion/conclusions.
- Individuals may submit more than one abstract.
- All abstracts will be reviewed for presentation as either a
 formal platform presentation on October 10th (15 minutes,
 to be presented in-person during the Abstract Platform
 Presentations session) OR as a poster. Select abstracts will
 be chosen for presentations during the Science Symposium
 and Lightening Science Talk portions of our conference.
