- All accepted abstracts will be published in ***Muscle & Nerve***.
- We welcome abstracts related to clinical investigations, basic science investigations, and information on clinical or educational resources. NEALS encourages collaborative projects.
- Up to two abstract submissions will be selected for 10-minute presentations during the Science Symposium portion of our conference.
 - *(Abstracts selected for the Science Symposium must align with the session's topic: **AI is NOW: Bringing AI into ALS Research.**)*
- Authors are encouraged to consider merging related submissions into a single abstract to provide a more cohesive and comprehensive representation of the research.
- Each abstract should be limited to 350 words and contain the background, hypothesis, methods, results to date (if ongoing) and discussion/conclusions.
- Individuals may submit more than one abstract.
