Recognize and respond to early signs of respiratory insufficiency in ALS patients by identifying at least two airway clearance and secretion management strategies and comparing national guidelines for initiating Respiratory Assist Devices (RADs) and Non-Invasive Ventilation (NIV), including variability in clinical practice.
2. Interpret and apply respiratory device data by analyzing real-world download reports from NIVs to assess patient compliance, identify ventilation leaks, and determine strategies for optimizing usage based on clinical scenarios presented.
3. Demonstrate hands-on proficiency with respiratory care equipment by correctly using a portable spirometer, operating at least two types of airway clearance or NIV devices, and outlining a plan to implement at least one new respiratory care tool or approach in their ALS clinic within three months of the workshop.
